Safe Lifting Operations

1. This circular serves as a safety reminder to all stevedores carrying out lifting operations.

- 2. During lifting operations, the communication between lifting members is important to prevent accidents. The appointed/qualified signalman must be visible to the crane operator at all times. For better visibility, signal light baton and/or walkie-talkie must be used to maintain visual /audio communication with the crane operator throughout the lifting operations.
- 3. A rule of thumb, suspended load must be prevented from swinging when hoisted up. Careful considerations of the method statement, center of gravity, and/or lifting method must be taken to ensure that the load can be hoisted up safely with minimum swing movement.
- 4. A tagline shall be attached to the load to minimize the movement and/or swaying of the suspended load. However, in situation whereby the use of tagline is not feasible, the risk must be re-assess and additional control measures must be implemented to mitigate the risk.
- 5. It is a requirement to conduct a thorough Risk Assessment (RA) for all work activities including non-routine work activities prior to work commencement. Any deviations from the original planned activities must be notified to Lifting Supervisor so that he can re-assess the risks and put in place control measures to ensure safe lifting operations.
- 6. We seek your compliance on the above requirements.
