To All Port Users,

STEEL STEVEDORING CHARGES – CHANGE OF UNIT OF MEASUREMENT FROM METRIC TONS TO REVENUE TONS.

We refer to the general tariff revision as proposed in various industry consultations/engagements since September 2019, involving members of the Singapore Shipping Association, Shippers, Consignees, Shipping Agents, Carriers and other port users and stakeholders.

We had mentioned that in relation to the steel stevedoring tariff implemented in 2017, that the unit of measurement at that time was inadvertently communicated as metric ton ("MT"). As a result, the community had adopted MT as the default unit of measurement which is not the industry practice. We wish to clarify that the correct unit of measurement should be Revenue Ton ("RT"). This is in line with all other historical and current Jurong Port charges and industry practice.

This has been accepted by the industry and approved by MPA. The change will therefore take effect from 16 Mar 2020 and onwards.
