MANDATORY USE OF TRACETOGETHER APP/ TOKEN TO ENTER JURONG PORT PREMISES

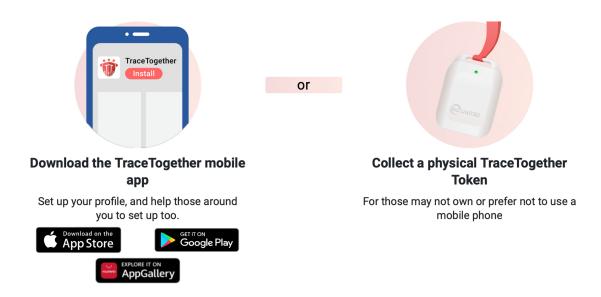
With reference to Jurong Port (JP) Circular No. 86 dated 17 November 2020, all personnel entering into JP's premises and tenant offices are required to check-in through the TraceTogether App on their mobile devices or with their TraceTogether tokens with effect from **21 December 2020**. With immediate effect, security personnel and gate ops staff will conduct check-in confirmation at all entry points.

As part of the criteria for Singapore to enter into Phase 3 as announced by the Multi-Ministry Taskforce, the usage of the TraceTogether check-ins are required at all public venues such as workplaces, progressively from 1 December 2020 (transition stage) and will be made compulsory in due course. During this transition period, any persons without either mode of TraceTogether check-in may continue to use the SafeEntry App until the TraceTogether App or token is made compulsory. Once TraceTogether is made compulsory, JP will exercise refusal of entry to port users without TraceTogether modes of check-in in alignment with the Multi-Ministry Taskforce's directive.
