WHEEL CLAMP AND TOW AWAY ENFORCEMENT AT JURONG PORT PASS **OFFICE CARPARK**

- 1. Jurong Port Security Department received numerous feedback regarding vehicles parking indiscriminately at the Pass Office Carpark and Heavy Vehicle parking lots. It also includes stopping a vehicle other than immediately picking up and dropping off passengers or goods. A waiting vehicle is considered parking even if the driver is present or the engine is running.
- 2. In the interest of general public safety and under the General Rules and Regulations for Jurong Port, you must park your vehicle at the designated parking lots. Parking indiscriminately can obstruct and create traffic congestion as heavy and long vehicles have to manoeuvre through tight spaces at the Pass Office Carpark. This may also block the view of pedestrians or other motorists, resulting in accidents.
- 3. With effect from 1st April 2023, motorists' vehicles violating Jurong Port's Rules and Regulations will be wheel clamped or towed away. Vehicle owners will bear the necessary fees.
- 4. Safety is our top priority. We thank you for helping us to continue making Jurong Port safer for everyone.
