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Dear Port Users

OVERLOADING AND SPILLAGE FROM HEAVY VEHICLES

As part of our efforts to improve safety, we would like to remind all port users that heavy vehicles carrying cement, aggregates and ready-mix concrete entering and exiting Jurong Port and RMC Eco-system should not be overloaded.

Overloaded vehicles can lead to spillage of materials onto the roads within Jurong Port, RMC Eco-system and on public roads which affects the cleanliness of our environment. Overloading can also damage a vehicle's chassis and affect its stability during steering and braking. This compromises the safety of both your drivers and other road users.

Please note that any person who causes or permits vehicles to carry a load that exceed the registered maximum laden weight of the vehicle would be in contravention of Rule 46 of Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) Rules (Cap. 276, R. 5).

Jurong Port will conduct ad hoc inspections and request for weighing of cement, aggregate and ready-mixed concrete trucks. If any vehicles are found to be exceeding the permissible laden weight, Jurong Port will take necessary actions against the tenant and driver.
