**PPE ZONES IN JURONG PORT**

This circular will supersede JP circular, No.23 of 2025, dated 4 Apr 2025

This circular is to be read with reference to previous circulars on the topic of PPE i.e., Circular No. 72 of 2021 (dated 16 September 2021).

This circular which establishes the PPE zones in Jurong Port will take immediate effect as provision of PPE is mandatory and currently in practise in the port premises. For detailed information on the PPE Zones at Jurong Port, please refer to:

- Annex A: PPE Zones at Homeport
- Annex B: Compulsory PPE by Zones

It is the duty of employer to conduct risk assessment to determine if any additional PPE is required for the work activities. If additional PPE is required, port users must comply with the risk assessment even within 'PPE free zones'.
